More tips to make the most of your **UEFA Women's EURO 2022 experience**:



Check your bag size

Bags larger than A4 or other oversized items won't be allowed inside the stadium.



Only bring the essentials



Make sure your mobile match ticket is ready

Transfer your tickets to others in your group via the UEFA Mobile Tickets app **before matchday**. On matchday between 11:00 – 11:30 (local time) your mobile tickets will be activated. You will need to open the UEFA Mobile Ticket app just once whilst connected to the internet to be ready for the match.



Get to the stadium early – gates open 2 hours before kick-off

Don't miss a minute of the action: Leave yourself enough time to get to the venue and locate your entrance, soak up the pre-match atmosphere, go through security, bag checks and to find your seat.



Charge your phone

You'll need it for your mobile match ticket and to take pics and videos of course! You can bring a small power bank if you're worried about running out of battery.



You can only use the entrance that's on your ticket.
And make sure you only use the seat assigned to you.



Plan your journey

Travel options to the stadium may differ from what you're used to. Check the Event Companion to find out about trains, shuttles, parking and how to get home after your match.



Join the Fan Festival

Get in on the action at the Fan Party (it's free!) and **check out all the Fan Festival events** happening in the host city on the Event Companion.



Show your colours, back your team

Think face paint, fun costumes and flags (up to 2.0 x 1.5 metres).



Don't forget, no re-admission 👄

Double check you have everything you need before entering the stadium.



Check the weather forecast

The weather is unpredictable so be prepared for rain or shine: Sunglasses and slathered on sunscreen or waterproofs and layers. **No umbrellas are allowed**, so bring a poncho instead.
